
## St. Paul the Apostle and Immaculate Conception Churches

#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

In praise of Latin.

Cardinal Newman said that one of the main things that led him into the Catholic Church was his "love of the literature of religion." I can say the same for myself – and in my case that includes the writings of Cardinal Newman. In my Catholic reading I was continually coming across bits of Latin, while at the same time, I had begun listening to Gregorian Chant. More and more, I was feeling that I was missing out on something that past generations had simply taken for granted: an easy familiarity with Latin.

At the time when I was working as an civil engineer, and growing in my faith, the idea came to me that it would not hurt to become acquainted with the Latin language. So I bought a copy of *Wheelock's Latin* and brought it to work. Spending a week or two on each chapter, during my lunch break, I soon finished the book. I found that Latin was an amazingly virile and versatile language.

A language is like a boat. It is meant for voyaging. Now that I had built the boat, I needed to sail it. St. Augustine was already one of my favorite saints, so I decided to start with him, reading his words in the language in which he wrote them. Without knowing it, I was a fulfilling one of the main imperatives of the Second Vatican Council: resourcement, getting back to the sources.

Our rule of faith is Sacred Scripture and Sacred Tradition. In order to better understand Tradition, we need to read the great Fathers of the Church in their original language. St. Jerome said that ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ. We can equally say that ignorance of Latin is ignorance of the Church. The historian Christopher Dawson wrote that Catholic faith is not possible without Catholic culture. The Latin language is woven into the fabric of our Catholic culture. To lose Latin is to lose our history, our roots, our identity.

Time and again, I have run into a prejudice against the use of Latin, which I do not understand. Pope Benedict XVI, in a letter to all the Bishops, stated: "What earlier generations held as sacred, remains sacred and great for us too, and it cannot be all of a sudden entirely forbidden or even considered harmful. It behooves all of us to preserve the riches which have developed in the Church's faith and prayer, and to give them their proper place."

In his Apostolic Exhortation on the Eucharist, Pope Benedict asked that "future priests, from their time in the seminary, receive the preparation needed to understand and to celebrate Mass in Latin, and also to use Latin texts and execute Gregorian chant; nor should we forget that the faithful can be taught to recite the more common prayers in Latin, and also to sing parts of the liturgy to Gregorian Chant."

The continued use of Latin in the Church requires no apology. It ought to be embraced warmly as an essential and cherished part of our Catholic culture.


