
### St. Paul the Apostle and Immaculate Conception Churches

#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Covering our father's nakedness

It is not my job to criticize Bishops or the Pope. There are journalists and Catholic commentators whose job it is to do just that, and they perform a necessary and valuable function in the Church. Clergy, especially those who occupy positions of responsibility, have to be held to account.

Aristotle describes virtue as the golden mean between deficiency and excess. Virtue, however, is not merely the mid-point on a linear scale but rather it is a lofty peak which rises above and from which one can decline on either side.

In the last couple months, the Church has been facing a deep crisis of conscience. First, it was revealed that a retired but still highly influential American Cardinal has a long history of sexual abuse. Then the Pennsylvania Grand Jury Report disclosed decades of clerical abuse and cover up. Finally, there has been a 'credible allegation' that the most highly placed people in the Vatican knew of that Cardinal's notorious reputation and did nothing about it.

Faced with these circumstances, we should try to hold to the golden mean.

On the one hand, we should not jump to conclusions and condemn people before all the facts are known. As Cardinal Newman long ago pointed out:

Scandals are petulant and press into view, and they are exaggerated from the shock they communicate to the beholders. Friends exaggerate through indignation, foes through malevolence. In the worst of times there is always a remnant of holy men out of sight, scanty perhaps in numbers, but great in moral strength.

On the other hand, we recognize that when *any* organization is facing a crisis, there is an almost automatic reflex to enter into a public relations exercise of 'damage control' or 'crisis management.' Especially, within the Church, there is a deeply imbedded instinct to 'avoid scandal.' This is often justified as 'covering our father's nakedness.' This comes from the story in Genesis:

Noah was the first tiller of the soil. He planted a vineyard; and he drank of the wine, and became drunk, and lay uncovered in his tent. And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father, and told his two brothers outside. Then Shem and Japheth took a garment, laid it upon both their shoulders, and walked backward and covered the nakedness of their father; their faces were turned away, and they did not see their father's nakedness. — Genesis 9:20-23

So then, what is the golden mean between peremptory condemnation and covering up? It is a sincere but insistent demand for the TRUTH, no matter how awful it is. *Qui tacet consentire videtur*. Silence is complicity.

For nothing is hidden that will not be disclosed, nor is anything secret that will not become known and come to light.
