
### St. Paul the Apostle and Immaculate Conception Churches

#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

"A crisis of truth."

It is impossible to ignore the current crisis in the Catholic Church, but it is also difficult to say anything about it that would be helpful. Like everyone else, I am waiting on developments. We are going through a period of trial which, by God's grace, may also be a period of purification. We cannot minimize the extent of the moral corruption which is coming to light nor can we make excuses for it. We can demand concrete action from Pope Francis and all the bishops, individually and collectively.

The problems which are currently being uncovered are not new. They are the symptoms of a chronic spiritual disease that Ralph Martin, in a book published in 1983, diagnosed as a "crisis of truth":

Increasingly a question mark is being placed over God's Word, its reliability questioned, its authority denied, its clarity obscured. Increasingly a relativistic and skeptical attitude to truth is arising even within' the hearts of many Catholics, even among those who hold positions of responsibility. This *crisis of truth* is certainly not the only crisis that the Church is facing today, but unless it is faced and resolved, the Church will not be able to meet the other crises which it faces. A firm and clear grasp on the authority and truth of God's Word is fundamental to the Church's existence.

I have stated repeatedly that if you want to understand the state of the Church in this present age you need to read Raymond Arroyo's biography of Mother Angelica, the founder of EWTN. Her no-nonsense teaching of the Catholic faith was what one would expect from a Catholic nun --- the same basic teaching that I received in grade two. Yet it often raised the anger of high-ranking bishops and Cardinals who promoted their own distorted versions of the Christian faith. Pope John Paul II said that "EWTN is the key to restoring the Roman Catholic Church in America."

The present crisis is a crisis of faith. It is worth recalling what Fr. Neuhaus wrote back in 2002:

I have said, and have been criticized for saying, that the sex abuse crisis is about three things: fidelity, fidelity, and fidelity. The criticism is that that doesn't say anything worth saying. It merely says that, had priests been faithful to their vows, they would have been faithful to their vows and there would have been no sex abuse crisis. As you might expect, I disagree. To say it is about fidelity is to say where the focus of attention must be. The issue is not teaching about "boundaries" between "appropriate" and "inappropriate" touching, nor is it, at least not in the first instance, about "sexual maturity." The great question is fidelity and, one hopes, fidelity on the way to holiness, as in wholeness. When we fall short of holiness, we can at least be faithful, and, please God, holiness will come in time.




