FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Christ the King.

Pilate asked Jesus, "Are you the King of the Jews?" Jesus answered, "Do you ask this on your own or did others tell you about me?" Pilate replied, "I am not a Jew, am I? Your own nation and the chief priests have handed you over to me. What have you done?" Jesus answered, "My kingdom is not from this world. If my kingdom were from this world, my followers would be fighting to keep me from being handed over to the Jews. But as it is, my kingdom is not from here."

Jesus truly is the "King of the Jews." He is the Messiah, but not the kind of Messiah that the Jewish people were expecting. The people were expecting a Messiah who would lead them in a revolt against the Romans, one who would re-establish the Kingdom of Israel and then sit on the throne as the rightful heir of King David.

Jesus does in fact establish a new Kingdom, but it is not the renewed nation-state of Israel. The disciples on the road to Emmaus, after Jesus' crucifixion, are dismayed: "We had hoped that he was the one who was going to redeem Israel." Their disappointment is understandable — but Jesus *is* the redeemer. He *is* as Martha of Bethany professes, "the Messiah, the Son of God, the one coming into the world." However, the kingdom that Jesus establishes does not have any geographical or ethnic boundaries. Rather, as the Prophet Zechariah says:

Rejoice greatly, O Daughter Zion! See your king comes to you: triumphant and victorious is he, humble and riding on a donkey. He will proclaim peace to the nations. His dominion shall be from sea to sea, and from the River to the end of the earth.

Jesus establishes not only a new Kingdom but a new Covenant. The Covenant that God made with Israel is not revoked — it is fulfilled. As the Prophet Jeremiah says: "The time is coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel."


In the book of the Prophet Haggai, the Lord says: "In a little while I will once more shake the heavens and the earth, the sea and the dry land. I will shake all the nations, and the desired of all the nations will come."

The Letter to the Hebrews comments on this:

At that time his voice shook the earth, but now he has promised, "Once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens." The words "once more" indicate the removing of what can be shaken — that is, created things — so that what cannot be shaken may remain. Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful.

St. Augustine wrote almost 1600 years ago:

"The Church will totter if its foundation shakes; but how can Christ be moved? Christ remaining immovable, the Church shall never be shaken."


