#### FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

The "New Evangelization"— Veritas et Caritas

More than forty years ago, in 1975, Pope Paul VI issued the encyclical *Evangelii Nuntiandi* on evangelization in the modern world. He noted that while the Gospel still needed to be proclaimed to people who had never heard of Jesus Christ, a new situation had also evolved. As Pope Paul expressed it:

Today there is a very large number of baptized people who, for the most part, have not formally renounced their baptism, but who are entirely indifferent to it and not living in accordance with it.

Parts of Europe and America that had for centuries been considered "Christian nations" had rapidly become almost completely secular and alienated from religion. We had entered an era of post-Christianity. This was not unforeseen. A century earlier Cardinal Newman had predicted "a coming time of widespread infidelity." He noted that even in his own day "the world at large, not only is not Christian, but cannot discern or understand the Christian."

Eighteen years ago, on the Feast of Epiphany, 2001, Pope John Paul II issued the encyclical *Novo Millennio Ineunte*, which he offered as the blueprint for the renewal of the Church in the new millennium. He wrote:

Even in countries evangelized many centuries ago, the reality of a "Christian society" which, amid all the frailties which have always marked human life, measured itself explicitly on Gospel values, is now gone. Over the years, I have often repeated the summons to the *New Evangelization*.

Pope Benedict XVI, carrying on the program of his predecessor, called together a Synod of Bishops in 2012. The theme of the Synod was "The *New Evangelization* for the Transmission of the Christian Faith." In his address to the assembled bishops, Pope Benedict said:

Evangelization is not an abstract thing, it is love (caritas). Only in this way is it really the reflection of divine truth (veritas), which as truth is also, inseparably, love. It is ardor, it is flame, it ignites others. Jesus told us: I have come to bring fire to the earth, and how I wish it were blazing already. Origen handed down to us a word of the Lord: "Whoever is close to me is close to fire". The Christian must not be lukewarm. The greatest danger for a Christian is not that he says 'no', but a very tepid 'yes'. This tepidness really discredits Christianity. Faith must become in us the flame of love, a flame that truly ignites my being and so ignites my neighbor. This is the way of evangelization: truth becomes charity in me and charity like fire ignites my neighbor. Only in this igniting of the other through the flame of our charity does evangelization, the presence of the Gospel which is no longer just words, but a lived reality, really grow.
