FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Blessed are the pure in heart.

Whenever you're called on to make up your mind, and are hampered by not having any, the best way to solve the dilemma, you'll find, is simply by tossing a penny.

No — not so that chance shall decide the affair while you're passively standing their moping; but the moment the penny is up in the air, you suddenly know what you're hoping.

That is a little poem I learned a very long time ago, and it has always stayed with me because it is so true. As the great Catholic scientist Blaise Pascal said: "The Heart has reasons that Reason knows nothing of."

The heart, in Scripture, is not only the seat of the emotions, but also of good and evil, folly and wisdom. Yet how difficult it is sometimes to know what lies within our own heart. In the book of the prophet Jeremiah we read: "The heart is devious above all else; it is perverse — who can understand it? I, the Lord, test the mind and search the heart, to give to all according to their ways, according to the fruit of their doings."

Jesus says that "what comes out of the mouth proceeds from the heart. The good person out of the good treasure of the *heart* produces good, and the evil person out of evil treasure produces evil; for it is out of the abundance of the *heart* that the mouth speaks."

The psalmist prays, "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and put a new and right spirit within me." In the sermon on the mount Jesus proclaims, "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God."

When we truly know something to be good and true, we know it not merely with our intellect but in the depths of our heart. St. Ambrose says: "This is our *Amen* — a Hebrew word that means 'So be it' or 'It is true.' What the mouth utters, the mind within acknowledges; what the word says, the *heart* ratifies."

In the *Book of Revelation*, Jesus identifies himself as "*The Amen*, the faithful and true witness." Jesus so often begins his teaching with, "*Amen*, *Amen*, I say to you." The NRSV translation, which is read at Mass, ineptly renders this, "*Very truly*, I tell you." *Amen* means so much more than this. St. Paul writes: "For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, whom we proclaimed among you, was not 'Yes and No'; but in him it is always 'Yes.' For this reason it is through him that we say the *Amen* to the glory of God."

Our *Amen* is our 'Yes' to Christ, arising from the depths of our heart. Christian conversion is nothing less than the transformation of the heart — the renewal of one's whole being brought about by the working of God's grace in the human soul. "Lift up your hearts! We lift them up to the Lord!" Faith is not only knowing the truth, but also *loving* the truth, with all our heart.
