

Saint of the Week:

Everybody needs beauty as well as bread, places to play in and pray in, where nature may heal and give strength to body and soul. - *St. Junipero Serra (1713-1784), Patron of Vocations, Feast Day July 1*

FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

"We must rebuild the Cathedral."

St. Francis of Assisi, as a young man still trying to discern God's will for him, found himself in the dilapidated old chapel of San Damiano in the countryside. As he prayed he heard a voice speak to him from the Cross: "Francis, go and repair my church which, as you see, is all in ruins." He immediately began to collect stones and lumber to restore the chapel. Later, he realized that Christ's words had a different meaning. The Church that he was to rebuild was not the chapel of San Damiano, but the Catholic Church!

Reflecting on the tragic fire which severely damaged Notre-Dame Cathedral in Paris, we can hear the voice of Christ speaking again: "Repair my Church."

Cardinal Robert Sarah recently gave a talk in Paris to introduce his latest book, *The Day Is Far Spent*. He began by saying:

Just hours ago I was at the Cathedral of Notre-Dame de Paris. As I entered the gutted Church, and contemplated its ruined vaults, I could not help but see in it a symbol of the situation of Western civilization and of the Church in Europe. Today, the Church seems to be engulfed in flames on all sides. We see her ravaged by a conflagration much more destructive than the one that damaged the Cathedral of Notre-Dame.

This blaze, this conflagration, is a case of intellectual, doctrinal and moral confusion. It is our loss of faith and the spirit of faith, a losing sight of the objectivity of faith and thus loss of the knowledge of God.

After thus surveying the damage, Cardinal Sarah proceeds to outline the steps that need to be taken.

My dear friends, we must rebuild the cathedral. We must rebuild it exactly as it was before. We do not need to invent a new Church. We have to let ourselves be converted so that the Church can shine once more, so that the Church can be once more a cathedral that sings God's glory and leads men to him. So, what is the first thing to do?

First, repair the vaults, the roof of the Church. We must restore *adoration*! "Do you want to rebuild the Church? Then we must get on our knees. A Cathedral is first of all a place where men can kneel, where God is present in the Most Holy Sacrament."

Next, the Church needs "solid pillars to support the vaults. The Catholic doctrine we have received from the Apostles is the only solid foundation we can find."

To finish the Cathedral "we still need stained glass. They let in the luminous presence, joyful and multi-colored of the saints in heaven. We need saints, who dare to be enlightened by the light of God."

Eight hundred years ago, Christ told St. Francis to rebuild the Church because it had been allowed to fall into ruin. That same voice is speaking to us today. We need to roll up our sleeves and start the work of rebuilding.
