

FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Novo anno ineunte — at the beginning of a new year.

The Holy Spirit is the cause of holiness in the Church. The renewal of the Church will only come about if we embrace this great truth.

At the beginning of the year 2001, Pope John Paul II issued the encyclical, *Novo Millennio Ineunte*, in which he presented a roadmap for the renewal of the Church. This document continues to be the point of reference for evaluating our current situation. Pope John Paul insisted on the necessity of prayer and the vital importance of the Sacraments of Confession and the Eucharist. Above all, however, the Pope emphasized that the 'essential principle of the Christian life' is the 'primacy of grace':

I have no hesitation in saying that all pastoral initiatives must be set in relation to holiness. There is a temptation which perennially besets every spiritual journey and pastoral work: that of thinking that the results depend on our ability to act and to plan. God of course asks us really to cooperate with his grace, and therefore invites us to invest all our resources of intelligence and energy in serving the cause of the Kingdom. But it is fatal to forget that 'without Christ we can do nothing.'

It is prayer which roots us in this truth. It constantly reminds us of the primacy of Christ and, in union with him, the primacy of the interior life and of holiness. When this principle is not respected, is it any wonder that pastoral plans come to nothing and leave us with a disheartening sense of frustration?

Forty days after his resurrection, before he ascended into heaven, Jesus entrusted to his disciples the 'great commission' to go and make disciples of all nations. They did not set up a committee, draw up a five-year plan or vote on policies and procedures. Instead they waited and prayed. On the feast of Pentecost the Holy Spirit came upon them. Then, in the power of the Spirit, they began to boldly proclaim the good news of Jesus Christ to the people of Jerusalem and then to the whole world.

We also are entrusted with the great commission to live and proclaim the Gospel. We do not have to wait for somebody else to get started on this. The renewal of the Church begins today with each of us individually. We are indeed living in troubled times. But as St. Augustine said: "Let us live good lives, and the times are good. We ourselves are the times."

Pope John Paul II wrote that we do not have to invent a new program:

The program already exists: it is the plan found in the Gospel and in the living Tradition, it is the same as ever. It has its center in Christ himself, who is to be known, loved and imitated. This is a program which does not change with shifts of times and cultures. This program for all times is our program for the Third Millennium.




