### **FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:**

*Lead kindly light.*

A long time ago I learned a little poem by Piet Hein:

Whenever you're called on to make up your mind,  
and you're hampered by not having any,  
the best way to solve the dilemma, you'll find,  
is simply by tossing a penny.

No, not so that chance shall decide the affair  
while you're passively standing there moping;  
but the moment the penny is up in the air,  
you'll suddenly know what you're hoping.

Lately I have been facing my own dilemma. Since the beginning of the Covid lockdowns I have been trying to spend as much time as possible with my Mom in Ottawa, who is now in her 92nd year and living at home. The lockdowns have been hard on the elderly, with isolation, reduced access to medical care and lack of physical activity.

The upshot is that I have been in conversation with the archdiocese to see if I can take some leave time to spend Christmas with family in Ottawa. The arrangements are not finalized yet, but I am hoping that I can be absent from the parish over the Advent and Christmas seasons, basically from mid-November to mid-January. It will be strange not to celebrate Christmas here, but, on the other hand, it will be my first Christmas with my family since my ordination thirteen years ago.

There will not, this year, be the usual spate of parish activity in December. Hopefully, in January there will be some easing of the lockdowns and we can catch up on our Sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion. I cannot help but feel guilty about abandoning my 'family' here — hence, the dilemma — but as I learned long ago, no one is indispensable, although our vanity may make us believe that we are. We do not always see where God is leading us. Sometimes we need to step out in faith.

Cardinal Newman wrote the poem *Lead Kindly Light* at an important crossroads in his life. The poem expresses his trust in God, even in the midst of uncertainty. He asks God to show him 'the next best step.'

Lead kindly light, amid the encircling gloom.

Lead thou me on.

I ask not to see the distant scene.

One step enough for me

As Ven. Bruno Lanteri has said:

God has placed me in this state of life; in this and in no other I must serve him. All the circumstances and events in my life reveal the order of Providence through which the Lord has willed to work my salvation. I must adapt myself to all these things and not think that I can force them to adapt themselves to me. And so, I will try always to adapt to these with peace and joy of heart, confident that God knows better than I what is best for me.

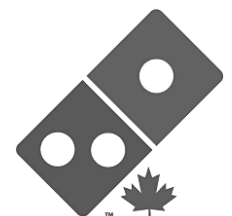
