FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

Characters in search of an author.

"Just because we're fictional characters doesn't mean you can pick us up and move us anywhere you want." — the people of Lake Woebegon to author Garrison Keillor.

When we read or watch fiction we immerse ourselves in alternate realities where almost anything is possible. Yet within those fictional worlds we want consistency. Tolkein, the creator of *The Lord of the Rings*, criticized C. S. Lewis for putting Santa Claus in *Narnia*. He was mixing up different worlds! Lewis responded that *Narnia* was exactly the kind of place one would expect Santa. In this debate, I am with Tolkein — Lewis broke the rules.

Almost all fiction, I have noticed, presents a world in which God is absent. This is not a recent phenomenon. For example, the old screen classic *Casablanca* deals with important themes — good and evil, love and loyalty — but it does so within a completely secular world-view. Other films may be overtly religious, such as *The Song of Bernadette*, but to what extent does the audience accept God in those stories as a true reality and not as a pious fiction?

Today, our culture is overwhelmingly secular. As Nietzsche's madman said: "God is dead, and we have killed him." The vast majority of people get along quite well without the least thought of God. Parents see value in Catholic education but have little fear that their children will adopt a Christian worldview. As one caller to a CBC radio show put it: "I had thirteen years of Catholic education, and it didn't hurt me." A Jewish intellectual wrote of his childhood education:

I am profoundly grateful that I attended Orthodox Jewish day schools. I studied under teachers who truly believe in God and Judaism. Their beliefs are more fundamentalist than mine, but I could temper those beliefs at home. It is much easier to be a secular influence on a religious child than to be a religious influence on a secular child.

So which world is real and which is fictional: the world with God, or the world without him? The religious worldview or the secular?

There are moments, in every life, when there is an encounter with the transcendent, however fleeting. There is a sudden flash of insight into the unseen spiritual realm. At those moments, we know that this present world is not all there is. As C. S. Lewis noted, even the staunchest atheist has his moments of doubt.

The Catholic philosopher Ralph McInerny presented a series of lectures entitled, "Characters in Search of an Author." God is not a character in our story — we are characters in his story (theologians call this 'providence'). Yet, within this story we exercise our own free will and agency. We all have a hand in the making of the story, for good or evil. In this story everything we do has eternal consequences. This is the reality of our world. We are not fictional characters. Neither is God.

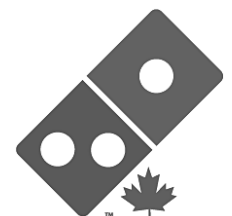
