

FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Alma Redemptoris Mater – Loving Mother of our Redeemer And a great portent appeared in heaven, a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars. — Revelation 12:1

This coming Wednesday, December 8th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In virtue of her role as the mother of Jesus, Mary had the unique grace of being conceived without Original Sin. As the prayer of the Mass says:

For you [Father] preserved the most Blessed Virgin Mary from all stain of Original Sin, so that in her, endowed with the rich fullness of your grace, you might prepare a worthy Mother for your Son and signify the beginning of the Church, his beautiful bride, without spot or wrinkle. She, the most pure Virgin, was to bring forth a Son, the innocent Lamb who would wipe away our offences; you placed her above all others to be for your people an advocate of grace and a model of holiness.

There was nothing 'ordinary' about Mary. There have been many great saints through the ages but Mary exceeds all of them in holiness. She possessed to a superlative degree the fruits of the Holy Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Jesus was an 'only child,' but I imagine that Mary's maternal heart embraced all the children in the neighborhood — they would have been irresistibly attracted to her. Her home must have been bustling with people coming to spend a little time with her, though perhaps they could not express what so strongly drew them.

Catholics are accused of being more devoted to Mary than to Jesus. I wish that there was more substance to the accusation, because the truth is that we are not devoted to Mary to the degree that she deserves. In any case, devotion given to Mary is not taken away from her Son. It is not as if we have a limited amount of devotion that must sparingly be parceled out. My regard for St. Augustine, for example, does not diminish my love for St. Teresa of Avila. Devotion is a deep well, fed by the Holy Spirit, and the more we draw from it, the more is supplied; it can never be depleted.

As Catholics we express our devotion to the Blessed Virgin in beautiful hymns and prayers but most of all by praying the *Rosary*. Pope John Paull II said, "The Rosary is my favorite prayer. It is marvelous in its simplicity and in its depth. It puts us in living communion with Jesus through his Mother's heart."

Throughout the year we have feast days which celebrate the Blessed Virgin and the indispensable role she played in God's plan of redemption. This coming Wednesday we again honor the unique grace she was given to prepare her for that role — being conceived without sin, with the fullness of grace, to be the loving Mother of our Savior.

Pray for us, O holy Mother of God, that we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.


