FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Behold, I bring you tidings of great joy.

Today our Savior is born. Let us rejoice. There is no place for sadness on the birthday of Life, who brings us joy with the promise of eternal happiness. No one is shut out from this joy. All share the same reason for rejoicing. In the fullness of time the Son of God took for himself our common humanity in order to reconcile us with the Father. And so at the birth of our Lord the angels sing in joy: Glory to God in the highest, and they proclaim peace on earth to people of good will. When the angels on high are so exultant at this marvelous work of God's goodness, what joy should it not bring to the lowly hearts of men? — Pope Leo the Great.

The joy of this Christmas season finds expression in innocent pleasures and by sharing with others — imitating, for example, the renowned generosity of the holy Bishop, St. Nicholas of Myra. We quite rightly wish each other a *merry* Christmas. We are not Puritans! It is said that Christmas is for children, but we can all experience anew the childhood wonder of this Christmas season.

We cannot help but lament the secularization of our most important holy days, seeing them reduced to mere seasonal festivities, purged as much as possible of their religious content. We may be tempted to disparage the cultural traditions associated with the celebration of Christmas as mere 'trappings' which detract from the 'true meaning.' This perhaps is a valid concern in our post-Christian society. And yet, if we live the faith all 365 days of the year, then these 'trappings' can serve to *accentuate* the true meaning of the day.

So many of our traditions — the Christmas carols, the crèche, even the angel at the top of the tree — all of these keep Jesus at the center of our celebrations. We ought to truly value our traditions, especially the ones that have been passed down through generations in our families. It is said that there can be no Catholic faith without Catholic culture. We owe it to ourselves and to the next generation to keep our Catholic culture vibrantly alive.

St. Leo the Great goes on to say:

Christ became the son of man so that men could become the sons of God. Unless in humility he had come down to us, none of us by our own merits could ever go up to him. Therefore, the greatness of the gift which he has given us demands proportional return. The only way that he can be worthily honored by us is by the gift to him of that which he has already given us. What can we offer more in keeping with the glory of this feast than that peace that was first announced by the angelic choir on the day of his birth? The birthday of the Lord is the birthday of peace. Let us offer to the Father our harmony as his children united in peace.

May God bless us all as we celebrate the birth of our Savior and grant us his blessings in the coming new year.
