**Baptisms:**

Parents/Guardians must be registered parishioners, and are required to attend the Baptism preparation class along with the godparents. Baptism classes are held on first Thursday of the month from 7:00 p.m.- 9:00 pm.

Registration package can be picked up from the parish office. Baptisms take place on **second** and **fourth** Sunday of each month, following the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Attendance at the Sunday Mass before the Baptism is mandatory.
