### From the desk of Father Norberto

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, we reflect on the journey of the Magi, who followed the star to find the newborn King. This beautiful feast reminds us that Christ is the Light of the World, revealed not only to Israel but to all nations and peoples. The word Epiphany means "manifestation" or "revelation," and it signifies the moment when Jesus was made known to the Gentiles, represented by the Wise Men.

The Magi, often depicted as kings or wise men from the East, teach us profound lessons about faith, perseverance, and worship. They undertook a long and difficult journey, guided only by the light of a star, in search of something greater than themselves. They show us what it means to seek God with humble and open hearts.

When they arrived at the manger, the Magi encountered not a mighty king in a palace but a humble child in the arms of his mother. Yet, they recognized His divine kingship and offered Him gifts that symbolized His mission: gold for His kingship, frankincense for His divinity, and myrrh for His sacrifice and death. Their response was worship, gratitude, and generosity - an example for all of us as we encounter Christ in our own lives.

The Feast of the Epiphany also marks the conclusion of the Christmas season, a season that may feel all too short but is filled with profound meaning. Over these weeks, we have celebrated the coming of Emmanuel - God with us - who entered into our humanity to bring light, hope, and salvation to the world. The Nativity, the Holy Family, and now the Epiphany remind us of the joy and wonder of God's love, revealed to us through His Son.

As we prepare to transition back into Ordinary Time, we are invited to carry the light of Christ with us into our daily lives. The Christmas season does not simply end - it leaves us with a renewed sense of purpose and mission. Just as the Magi returned to their homes "by another way", we too are called to live differently because of our encounter with Christ.

The feast of the Epiphany challenges us to continue to seek Christ daily. Like the Magi, we must be willing to search for Him in prayer, in Scripture, in the Sacraments, and in one another. God reveals Himself to those who seek Him with sincere hearts. We are encouraged to share the light of Christ with others. The Epiphany reminds us that Christ came for all people, and we are called to be witnesses of His love. This can be as simple as acts of kindness, offering a listening ear, or reaching out to those who are lonely or in need. And finally, we are being asked to bring our own "gifts" to Christ. The Magi brought gifts of great value, but the greatest gift we can offer is our hearts. As we enter a new year, let us commit to giving Christ our time, talents, and love, using these gifts to build His kingdom here in our parish and beyond.

Even as we wrap up the Christmas season, the light of Christ does not fade. It continues to shine brightly, calling us to follow Him more closely and to bring His hope to a world that still longs for light in the midst of darkness.

May this Feast of the Epiphany inspire us to seek, worship, and share Christ more deeply. And as we move into the weeks ahead, let us carry the joy of Christmas with us, knowing that God is with us always.

Wishing you and your families a blessed Epiphany and a grace-filled year ahead.
