

### From the desk of Father Norberto:

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we journey through the final weeks of Lent, we are reminded of God's constant call to mercy, renewal, and hope. These three themes are at the heart of our faith and are especially relevant as we prepare for the great Jubilee of 2025, embracing our call to be Pilgrims of Hope.

### Mercy: God's Endless Gift

Mercy is the foundation of our relationship with God. No matter how far we may have strayed, God's love remains constant, always ready to embrace us with compassion. Lent is a time to reflect on this divine mercy—not only to seek it for ourselves but to extend it to others.

Too often, we hold onto past hurts, judgments, and resentments. But true mercy calls us to forgive as we have been forgiven. When we choose mercy over condemnation, we break free from the chains of bitterness and allow God's grace to heal our hearts. This is the mercy that Jesus exemplifies—a mercy that does not ignore sin but seeks transformation, a mercy that does not condemn but calls to new life.

### **Renewal: A Fresh Start in Christ**

God is always doing something new. As Isaiah proclaims, "Now it springs forth, do you not perceive it?" (Isaiah 43:19). The season of Lent is a journey of renewal, an opportunity to leave behind what weighs us down and embrace the new life God offers.

It means recognizing our weaknesses and sins, not with despair, but with the confidence that God's grace can make us whole again. Through prayer, fasting, and acts of charity, we prepare our hearts for the joy of Easter—a joy that comes from knowing that death, sin, and suffering do not have the final word.

### **Hope: Walking Toward the Future with Trust**

As we prepare for the Jubilee 2025, we are called to be Pilgrims of Hope. A pilgrim is someone who keeps moving forward, trusting in the journey even when the road is uncertain. Hope is what keeps us walking in faith, even in difficult times.

Hope is not simply wishful thinking. It is the deep assurance that God is with us, guiding us toward a future filled with His love. In a world where so many struggle with fear, doubt, and despair, we are called to be witnesses of hope. This means encouraging one another, supporting those in need, and living in a way that reflects our trust in God's promises.

As Pilgrims of Hope, let us walk together, as a parish and as a Church, toward the great celebration of the Jubilee, with hearts open to God's mercy, ready for renewal, and filled with the hope that comes from Christ.
