#### From the desk of Father Norberto

Dear beloved parishioners,

#### Christ is Risen! Alleluia! Alleluia!

With hearts overflowing with joy, we gather this Easter Sunday to proclaim the central truth of our faith: Jesus Christ, who was crucified, has been raised from the dead! The tomb is empty, death has been defeated, and the light of the Risen Christ now shines on the whole world. This is the Day the Lord has made, and we rejoice in it, not just because of what happened two thousand years ago, but because the power of the Resurrection is still at work in us, in our Church, and in our world.

This year's Easter celebration is made even more meaningful as we journey together towards the Jubilee Year 2025, with the beautiful theme: "Pilgrims of Hope." How fitting it is that we stand today at the threshold of the greatest hope ever known - the hope of the Resurrection. We are not a people who walk in darkness, but a people who walk in the light of Christ. Easter is not the end of a story but the beginning of a new pilgrimage - a path that leads us from the shadows of despair into the dawn of new life.

In a world often marked by fear, anxiety, war, division, and uncertainty, we, the Church, are called to be pilgrims of hope - people who journey with confidence in the promises of God. The Resurrection is the ultimate sign that love is stronger than hatred, peace more enduring than war, and life more powerful than death. And because Christ lives, our hope is not wishful thinking but a firm anchor for our souls.

The Holy Father reminds us that the Jubilee is not only a time of celebration but of renewal—a sacred invitation to rediscover the joy of the Gospel, to walk more closely with Christ, and to witness more boldly to the world. As Easter people, we are invited to bring the light of the Resurrection into our homes, our workplaces, our schools, and every corner of society.

But this pilgrimage of hope is not one we undertake alone. It is a journey of communion, together as a Church, as a parish family, and as brothers and sisters in Christ. Like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, we walk together, even when the road is long and unclear, trusting that Christ walks with us, often in ways we do not at first recognize.

As your pastor, I see daily signs of this hope among you. I see it in the parents passing on the faith to their children, in our young people longing for deeper meaning, in the quiet acts of kindness shown to the sick and the elderly, in your perseverance through personal trials, and in the way you come together as a community of prayer, worship and service. You are already pilgrims of hope, and this Easter calls us to walk forward with even greater purpose and trust.

Let us not keep the joy of Easter to ourselves. Let us be radiant witnesses to the Resurrection, voices of peace in troubled times, and messengers of God's mercy to those who feel forgotten or lost. Let our lives proclaim: "Christ is alive, and He is our hope!"

In this Easter season and in our journey toward the Jubilee, may we open our hearts ever wider to the Risen Lord. May we allow His light to heal our wounds, His mercy to restore our souls, and His Spirit to guide our steps. Together, let us move forward - not as tourists through life, but as pilgrims with a purpose.

May Mary, Mother of Hope and Star of the New Evangelization, accompany us on the road. And may this Easter fill you and your loved ones with peace, joy, and an unshakable hope that can never be extinguished.
