



From the desk of Father Norberto

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ.

Grace and peace to you in our Risen Lord Jesus Christ!

On this Fifth Sunday of Easter, and in the heart of our Jubilee Year, we rejoice as the Holy Spirit continues to breathe new life into the Church. We are especially filled with gratitude and hope at the election of our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV. His election marks not only the continuity of apostolic leadership but the beginning of a new season of grace, a spiritual springtime full of promise for the people of God.

This Sunday's Gospel gives us the very heart of Jesus' message to His disciples: "I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another."

These words are not just a command. They are an invitation into the very life of Christ. As Jesus prepares to go to the cross, He distills His mission down to its purest form: love. Not a love of convenience or comfort, but a love that mirrors His own -sacrificial, enduring, and transforming.

How fitting that we hear this Gospel in the same moment we welcome Pope Leo. In his first words to the world, he echoed the message of Christ: *calling for unity over division, mercy over judgment, compassion over fear.* His demeanor and tone already speak volumes - not of worldly power, but of servant leadership. He comes to us as a shepherd, echoing the Lord's command: "Love one another."

The arrival of a new pope always brings a sense of renewed energy and hope. But this moment is especially significant. We find ourselves at a time when the world deeply hungers for authenticity, peace, and healing. The Church, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit and the leadership of Pope Leo, is called to respond - not with clever strategies or human strength, but with Gospel love. His papacy begins as a prophetic sign of God's ongoing care for His Church and the unfolding of a greater mission.

As we journey through this Jubilee Year, the timing feels providential. A jubilee is a sacred time of renewal, a time when debts are forgiven, relationships are restored, and the people return to the heart of worship. It is a time of joy, justice, and mercy. The Holy Spirit is clearly moving, and this holy year gives each of us a fresh opportunity to live our faith more deeply. With Pope Leo leading us, we are being called to take this Gospel of love and make it visible in the world especially to the poor, the marginalized, the forgotten, and the weary.

Here in our own parish community, this Gospel takes root in simple but powerful ways. Every act of kindness, every word of encouragement, every moment of service becomes a reflection of the "new commandment" Jesus gives us today. As we celebrate baptisms, confirmations, first communions, and the quiet miracles of daily Christian living, we participate in the very renewal we hope for

Let us pray for Pope Leo that the Lord may grant him wisdom, courage, and deep peace. Let us support him with our prayers, our faithfulness, and our willingness to be co-workers in the vineyard of the Lord. And let us also recommit ourselves, as individuals and as a parish, to the great commandment Jesus gives us today: to love one another as He has loved us.

In the coming weeks and months, may our hearts remain open to the new things God is doing. Let us be bold in faith, generous in love, and joyful in witness. For this is our time, this is our Easter season, our jubilee, our moment to shine with the light of Christ. With gratitude and joy in the Risen Lord,
