

From the desk of Father Norberto

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend, we celebrated the Sacrament of Confirmation - a profound moment when our young men and women are sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit and sent forth as mature members of the Church. How fitting it is that this Sunday, our gospel contains Jesus' beautiful promise of the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, who will come to dwell within us and guide us. Jesus says, "The Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you. Peace, I leave with you; my peace I give to you." These words are spoken by Jesus just before His suffering and death. Jesus knows the fear and uncertainty His disciples feel. He reassures them and us that we will never be left alone.

In Confirmation, we also witness that this promise is being fulfilled. The same Spirit who descended upon the apostles at Pentecost comes to dwell in the hearts of our Confirmandi. Through this sacrament, they receive strength to live as disciples, witnesses to Christ in the world. They are anointed for a mission not just to believe, but to live their faith courageously and joyfully.

To those being confirmed: the Holy Spirit is now with you always. You are not alone. The Advocate walks with you as your guide, comforter, teacher, and strength. You have been given gifts for a purpose and not only for yourselves, but for the good of the Church and the world. You are called now to live with conviction, to bring light where there is darkness, and to speak truth where there is confusion.

Our celebration of Confirmation also resonates deeply with our journey through the Jubilee Year 2025, in which the whole Church is invited to walk as Pilgrims of Hope. As pilgrims, we recognize that we are always on a journey - sometimes challenging, often uncertain, but always accompanied by God's grace.

Hope is not wishful thinking. It is rooted in the assurance that God is at work, even when we do not see the whole picture. The Holy Spirit is the very source of that hope. The Holy spirit is quietly guiding, gently reminding, powerfully strengthening us to keep going, especially when the path ahead seems unclear.

Our Confirmandi are also stepping into this journey in a new and deeper way. But this moment is not just for them - it's a reminder to all of us to renew our commitment to walk by faith, to listen to Spirit's promptings, and to be people of peace and purpose in our homes, our parish, and our communities.

Jesus says, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give it to you." The peace Jesus offers is different. It is not an escape from the world but a deep calm within us, born from the Spirit's presence. This peace empowers us to face the world with courage, rooted in love.

As we continue our Jubilee pilgrimage, may we all be renewed in the Holy Spirit. Let us walk forward as pilgrims of hope, confident that we are never alone. The Advocate is with us, teaching, strengthening, and sending us forth to be Christ's presence in the world.
