

From the desk of Father Norberto

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we begin this holy season of Advent, our hearts are once again invited to prepare for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Advent is a time of hope, a time of reflection, and a time of joyful anticipation. It reminds us that, in the midst of our busy lives, God is always near, calling us to pause, to listen, and to open our hearts to His saving presence.

This year, our Advent journey is even more special. We prepare not only for the birth of Christ at Christmas, but also to celebrate 150 years of St. Paul Parish - 150 years of faith, devotion, and community life rooted in the Gospel. We give thanks for the generations of faithful men and women who have built and nurtured this parish, who have taught us to love God and one another, and who have passed down the gift of faith as a living treasure. Each stone of our church, each tradition, each ministry, is a witness to the Lord's faithfulness. Our celebration is a testimony that God has truly been with us, guiding, sustaining, and inspiring us in every season of our journey.

At the same time, we approach the closing of the Jubilee Year: Pilgrims of Hope. This Jubilee has been a time of renewal, a time to reflect on God's mercy, and a time to strengthen our commitment to living as people of hope. In this Advent season, let us reflect on three important truths that guide our preparation:

First, Advent is a season of hope. The prophets of old spoke of a coming Savior who would bring justice, peace, and salvation. Today, we continue to wait in joyful hope for Christ to be born anew in our hearts. In every Eucharist, in every act of love and mercy, Christ comes to us again.

Second, Advent is a season of reflection. As we prepare for our parish's 150th anniversary, we look back with gratitude and ask: How have we lived our faith? How can we grow in love for God and neighbor? Reflection allows us to see God's hand in our history and inspires us to embrace our calling with renewed courage.

Third, Advent is a season of mission. The Lord comes to us not only to bless us but to send us forth. As pilgrims of hope, we are called to be light for others, to bring peace where there is conflict, hope where there is despair, and love where there is indifference. Our parish's history teaches us that faith flourishes when it is shared, when the community reaches out, and when every member becomes a witness to Christ's mercy and joy.

Brothers and sisters, this Advent let us journey together with hearts full of hope, gratitude, and purpose. Let us welcome Christ into our homes, our families, and our parish community. Let us celebrate our 150 years not only as a milestone of history but as a living testimony of faith. And let us close the Jubilee Year as pilgrims renewed in hope, ready to continue the mission entrusted to us by Christ

May the Lord bless you abundantly this Advent season, and may our hearts be ever ready to receive Him who comes to save us.
