

From then desk of Father Norberto

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

On this Second Sunday of Advent, the Church gives us a powerful vision through the words of the prophet Isaiah and the voice of John the Baptist. Isaiah proclaims a world transformed—a world where the wolf shall dwell with the lamb, and where justice and peace blossom under the Spirit of the Lord. John the Baptist stands in the desert crying out, "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His paths." Together, they teach us that Advent is not passive waiting but active readiness—a hope that reshapes our hearts and our community.

This Advent holds special meaning for our parish. We are approaching the close of the Jubilee Year, a year in which the universal Church invited us to rediscover the mercy and tenderness of God. A Jubilee is always a time of release, healing, and new beginnings. As it draws to an end, we are called not to simply close a book, but to open a new chapter with gratitude and renewed purpose.

At the same time, our parish prepares for a blessed milestone: the 150th Anniversary of St. Paul Parish. For a century and a half, countless parishioners, families, pastors, and religious have prayed here, sacrificed here, healed here, and passed on the faith here. They lived the Gospel with generosity and courage. What we inherit today is not just a building, but a legacy of faithfulness—a living testimony that God has been walking with this community from its earliest days.

In this sacred moment, Advent, the Jubilee, and our anniversary converge into a single invitation: renewal.

John the Baptist's call echoes strongly for us:

"Prepare the way of the Lord."

Prepare your hearts.

Prepare your homes.

Prepare our parish community for the grace that God desires to pour out as we cross into our 150th year.

The Scriptures this Sunday remind us that renewal begins with humility. John urges conversion—a turning away from what is empty and a turning toward what gives life. Isaiah reminds us that true peace comes not from human plans but from the Spirit of the Lord resting upon us. And Advent teaches us that Christ comes quietly, gently, patiently—into hearts that make room for Him.

As we light the second candle of the Advent wreath—the candle of Peace—let us recommit ourselves to the mission entrusted to St. Paul Parish: to be a home where Christ is welcomed, worshipped, shared, and lived. Let us honor the generations who have gone before us by building a future that is even more rooted in prayer, generosity, and evangelizing love.

May this Advent be for each of us a time of deep spiritual awakening.

May the closing of the Jubilee Year seal in us the grace of conversion.

And may our journey toward 150 years make us a parish shining with hope for the decades to come.

Come, Lord Jesus. Prepare our hearts. Renew our parish. Guide us into a future filled with Your peace.
