From the desk of Father Norberto

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In God's beautiful design, the Church allows us this year to celebrate, within the same week, the Feast of the Holy Family, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, and the beginning of the New Year. This is not a coincidence, but a profound invitation to reflect on how faith, family, and hope are deeply woven together in our Christian life.

We begin with the Feast of the Holy Family. In Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, we see a family that was simple, humble, and deeply rooted in trust in God. Their home in Nazareth was not without struggle or uncertainty, yet it was filled with love, obedience, and prayer. By placing this feast at the heart of the Christmas season, the Church reminds us that God chose to enter the world through a family. In doing so, He sanctified family life itself. Our own families - imperfect, diverse, and sometimes fragile - are precious in God's eyes. They become holy when Christ is welcomed at the center and when love, forgiveness, and faith are lived each day.

As we continue this sacred week, we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. This title affirms the great mystery of Christmas: that the child born in Bethlehem is truly Emmanuel, God-with-us. Mary's motherhood is not only biological, but deeply spiritual. Through her humble "yes," she became the first disciple and the model of faith for the Church. In honoring Mary, we are reminded that God accomplishes great things through humility, trust, and openness to His will. As our Mother, Mary continues to accompany us, intercede for us, and gently lead us closer to her Son.

These two feasts naturally lead us to the celebration of the New Year. Standing at the threshold of a new beginning, we pause to give thanks for the year that has passed - for blessings received, lessons learned, and for God's faithful presence in moments of joy and trial. At the same time, we look ahead with hope, aware that the future is unknown but held securely in God's loving hands.

Celebrating all these moments in one week gives us a powerful message: the future of the world begins in families, is nurtured by faith, and is entrusted to God. The New Year invites us to renew our commitment to making our homes places of prayer, peace, and love. It calls us to imitate the Holy Family in patience and trust, and to follow Mary in saying "yes" to God, even when the path ahead is unclear.

As a parish community, this week also challenges us to live more deeply our vocation as one family in Christ. May we support one another, care for the vulnerable, and become signs of hope in a world longing for peace. The peace we desire for the New Year begins in our hearts, grows in our families, and flows outward through our parish into the wider community.

May the Holy Family bless all our families. May Mary, Mother of God, cover us with her loving intercession. And may the New Year be a time of renewed faith, deeper love, and lasting peace for each one of you.
