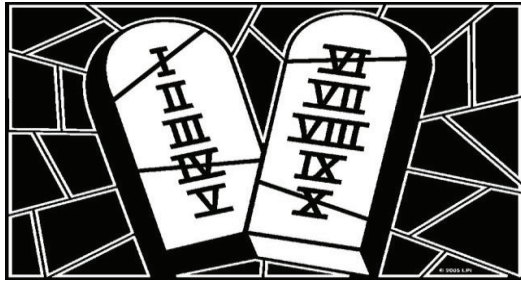

***From the desk of Father Norberto***

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As your pastor, it brings me deep joy to greet you on this beautiful occasion of Mother's Day. Today, we give thanks to God for the gift of mothers - women whose love reflects something sacred and enduring, something that quietly reveals to us the tenderness of God's own heart.

A mother's love is one of the most powerful signs of God's presence in our lives. It is patient, faithful, and self-giving. It is seen in countless hidden sacrifices - long days and sleepless nights that often go unnoticed. Mothers love, not because it is easy, but because it is who they are. In their care, we catch a glimpse of how God loves each one of us: unconditionally, generously, and without measure.

As a Church, we hold you in prayer, asking the Lord to console, heal, and fill every heart with His peace.

Dear mothers, your vocation is not always easy, but it is profoundly holy. Every act of love, no matter how small, becomes a reflection of God's grace at work in the world. Your patience, your strength, and your unwavering dedication are a blessing not only to your family but to the entire Church.

On this day, I encourage all of us to express our gratitude. Let us take the time to say, "thank you," to offer a prayer, or to show kindness to the mothers and motherly figures in our lives. And for those whose mothers have gone before us, may we cherish their memory and entrust them to the loving mercy of God.

With a grateful heart, I offer my prayers and blessings to all mothers in our parish. May the Lord continue to strengthen you, guide you, and fill you with His peace and joy. And may you always know how deeply appreciated and loved you are.
