From the desk of Father Norberto

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This Sunday, the Church invites us to contemplate one of the deepest and most beautiful mysteries of our faith: the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. We profess that God is One God in Three Divine Persons - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is a mystery not meant simply to be solved by the mind, but to be embraced by the heart and lived in daily life.

The Trinity teaches us that at the very center of God's being is love, relationship, and perfect unity. The Father loves the Son; the Son loves the Father; and the Holy Spirit is the bond of that eternal love. God is not isolation. God is communion. God is unity in diversity.

In a world often marked by division, conflict, misunderstanding, and individualism, the Holy Trinity becomes both our model and our calling. As parishioners, families, and members of one Body of Christ, we are invited to mirror that divine unity. Unity does not mean sameness. The Father is not the Son; the Son is not the Spirit. Yet they live in perfect harmony, self-giving love, and mutual communion.

Our parish community is blessed with people of different ages, backgrounds, gifts, and experiences. Like the Trinity, our diversity becomes beautiful when rooted in love and directed toward a common mission. We build unity when we forgive one another, listen with compassion, serve generously, and choose understanding over judgment.

The mystery of the Trinity also reminds us that faith is not merely knowledge about God; it is relationship with God. Every time we make the Sign of the Cross - "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit" - we are entering into the life and love of the Triune God. We are reminded that we belong to God and are called to reflect His love in the world.

The Father continually creates and provides for us. The Son redeems and walks beside us. The Holy Spirit strengthens, guides, and sanctifies us. God never abandons His people. The Trinity reveals a God who desires closeness with us and invites us into divine communion.

May this feast renew our commitment to become instruments of unity in our homes, parish, and society. Let us become living witnesses that love is stronger than division, service greater than selfishness, and communion more powerful than isolation.

May the Father bless and protect us. May the Son walk with us and strengthen us. May the Holy Spirit fill our hearts with peace and wisdom.

And may the Holy Trinity - Father, Son, and Holy Spirit - draw us ever deeper into the mystery of divine love.
