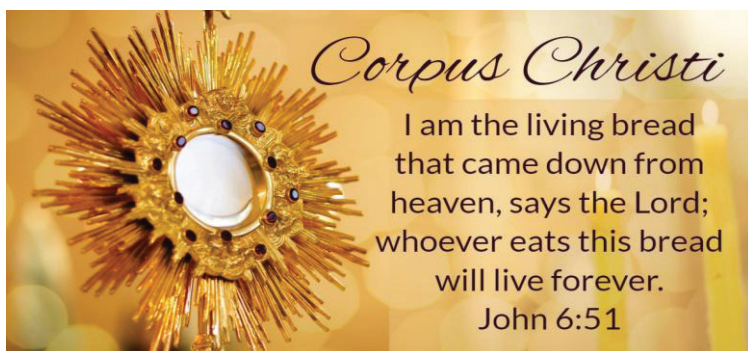

From the desk of Father Norberto

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known as Corpus Christi. It is a day when we pause to give thanks for the greatest gift Jesus entrusted to His Church - the Holy Eucharist. At the heart of our Catholic faith is the profound belief that in the Eucharist, Jesus Christ is truly present: Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. What we receive at Holy Communion is not merely a symbol or reminder of Christ, but Christ Himself, who continues to nourish, strengthen, and accompany us on our journey of faith.

The Eucharist is God's enduring answer to humanity's deepest hunger. Every human heart longs for meaning, peace, love, and communion with God. Jesus knew this hunger and, in His infinite love, gave us the Bread of Life. At the Last Supper, He took bread, blessed it, broke it, and gave it to His disciples, saying, "This is my body." He took the cup and said, "This is my blood." Through these words, He established the Eucharist and commanded His disciples to continue this sacred memorial in His name.

Every time we gather for Mass, we are invited into the mystery of Christ's sacrifice and resurrection. The Eucharist is not simply a recollection of an event that happened two thousand years ago; it is the living presence of Christ among us today. At every altar, heaven touches earth. Christ offers Himself to the Father for our salvation and invites us to unite our lives, joys, struggles, and prayers with His perfect offering.

The Eucharist also reminds us that faith is never meant to be lived in isolation. St. Paul teaches that because there is one bread, we who are many are one body. When we receive Holy Communion, we are united not only with Christ but also with one another. The Eucharist creates and strengthens the bonds of Christian community. It calls us to move beyond individualism and to live as brothers and sisters who care for one another, especially the poor, the lonely, the sick, and those who suffer.

The saints understood the transformative power of the Eucharist. They found strength in times of trial, courage in moments of fear, and joy amid suffering because they remained close to Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. The same Lord who sustained them is present among us today, waiting to renew and strengthen us with His grace.

May this beautiful feast rekindle our love for the Eucharist and deepen our devotion to the Lord who gives Himself completely to us. Let us approach the altar with grateful hearts and renewed faith. And having been nourished by Christ, may we go forth to become His living presence in our families, our parish, and our community.

May Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament bless you and your loved ones abundantly.

Sacrament Preparation information for registered parishioners

Baptism

If you wish to have your **infant or toddler baptized**, please pick up a **Baptism Registration Package** from the parish office.

Children **6 years of age and older** to be baptised, will be required to participate in the **Rite of Christian Initiation for Children (RCIC)** program first.

First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion Registration is open for **First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion** for the **2026-27** school year. Parents may register their child entering **Grade 2** or older at the following link. This link will also be posted to the church website. The deadline for registration is **Wednesday September 16**. Details of parent meetings and class dates will be sent out to those who register. The registration fee of **\$50.00** and a **copy of the child's baptismal certificate** can be dropped in the office sealed in an envelope or handed to Fr. Norberto after masses throughout the summer or brought to the first parent meeting.
